A luncheon consisting of a variety of tasty Chinese dishes, including delicious homemade Jung will be served, accompanying with entertainment, lucky draws and more.


Bring along family and friends to gather for a catch up, meet to make new friends in sharing together a celebration of the traditional Jung Festival.
