The other Ng families originated from from 3 other villages near San Mu;-- Look Nguen, (, Ai Lem Lee, (\Box \dot{n} \Box) and Ai Gem Han, (\Box $\dot{\tilde{v}}$) and a village called Thlee Giu, ($\dot{\tilde{v}}$) which is southwest of Hoi Siang city and also from a village in the district of Goong Yat" ($\dot{\tilde{v}}$) which is north of "Hoi Siang" city.
